The Seasoned Actuaries Section consists of CAS members who have been members for 25 or more years, or who are retired, or who are considering retiring in five years or less.

The Seasoned Actuaries Section was formed in November 2006 and is making good progress on becoming established. Face-to-face meetings are held at the Spring and Annual CAS meetings in the second concurrent session time slot on Monday afternoon and, since not everyone can attend CAS meetings every time, much is done via e-mail.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

1. **NEXT MEETNG**--our next meeting is on Monday November 17, at 3:30 at the CAS meeting in Seattle, Washington. We will discuss (a) the proposed content outline of the commemorative book "CAS History" that is being prepared for the CAS Centennial and (b) possible roles for SAS members in the CAS Leadership Development effort.

2. **ELECTIONS**-- In addition, we will elect officers for the upcoming year. Chuck Bryan automatically becomes President. Rich Fein has accepted the nomination as President-Elect and Patricia Teufel has accepted the nomination as Secretary-Treasurer. Finally, we may consider several by-law amendments.

3. **ACTUARIES WITHOUT FRONTIERS** --Glenn Meyers, chair of the Developing Countries committee, again reminds us that people with interests in developing countries can look into the Actuaries Without Frontiers section of the IAA.
